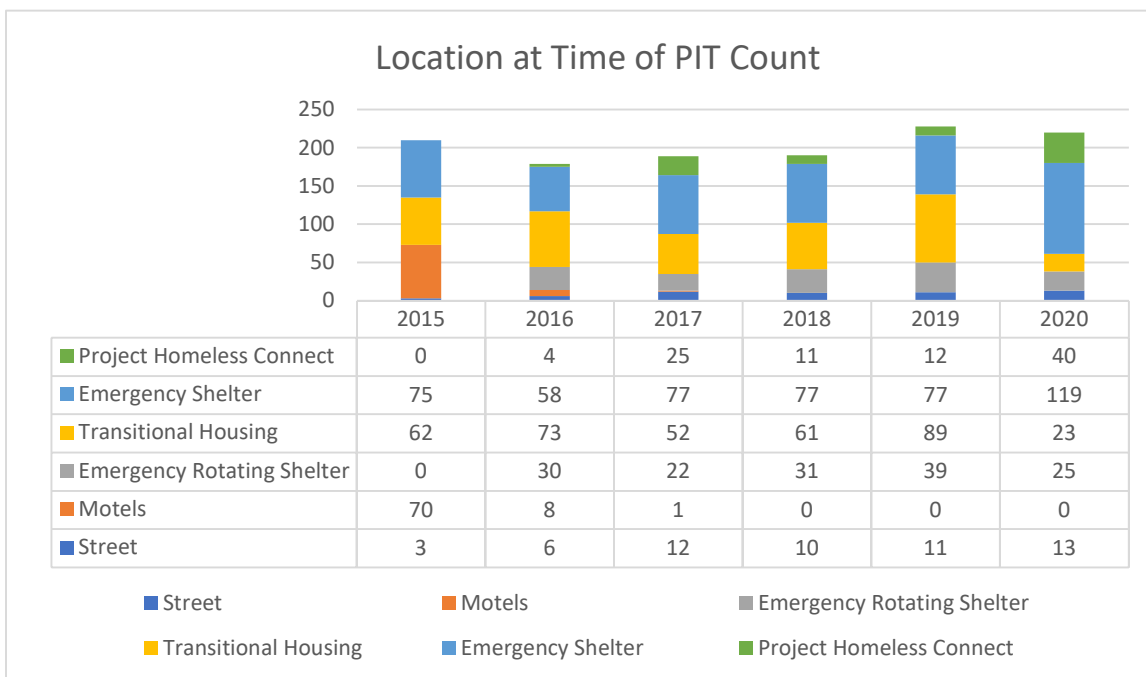


2020 Harford County (MD-502) Homeless Point-in-Time Count

Harford Community Action Agency leads the annual Point-in-Time (PIT) Count during the last 10 days in January. This count captures the number of individuals experiencing homelessness on the streets and in shelters on a single night. This year's count took place on January 22, 2020.



*In 2019, Harford Family House changed many of their housing units from a Transitional Housing designation to an Emergency Shelter Designation, thus resulting in a sharp decrease in TH numbers and sharp increase in ES numbers for 2020's PIT Count.

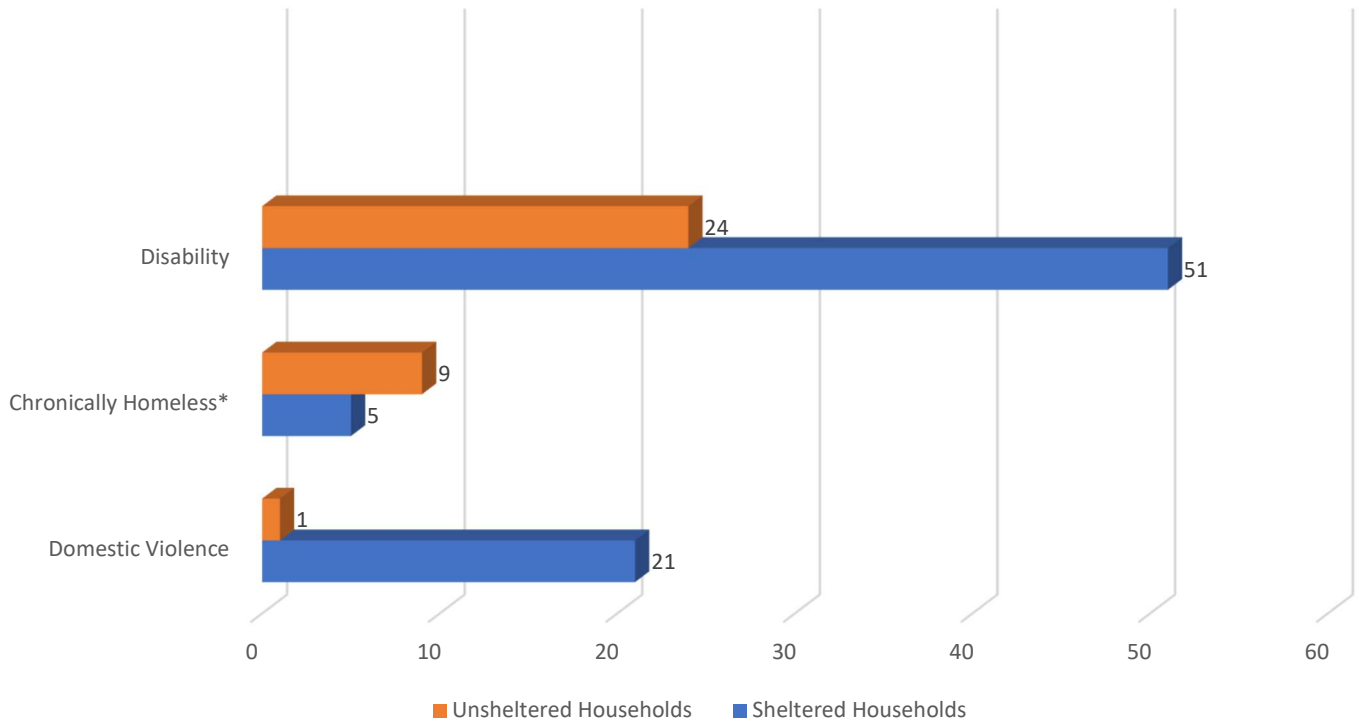
