Residential COVID Water and Sewer Emergency Assistance Program



What is it?

The Residential COVID Water and Sewer Assistance Program provides financial assistance with water and sewer bills for Harford County residents who have experienced a financial loss due to the COVID 19 pandemic.

Who is eligible?

Eligible applicants must be Harford County residents, making below 80% of area median income as defined by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development, and prove a financial loss due to COVID-19.

Funds will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is exhausted.

How much will I receive?

Payments are made directly to the water and sewer provider on the customer's behalf. The amount will depend on your circumstances. Past due bills prior to March 1, 2020 are not eligible for this funding.

How do I apply?

Funding is dependent on availability of Federal CARES Act funds. Applications and program guidelines are available online at www.HarfordCAA.org.

Applicants will be asked to provide the following documentation:

1. Proof of termination of employment (if available)
2. Last three pay stubs prior to job loss or decrease in employment
3. Most recent bank statement
4. Verification of all benefits within the last 30 days (unemployment, food stamps) for all household members
5. Most recent water and sewer bill with address and account number
6. Fully executed rental/lease agreement and rental addendums OR mortgage statement within the last 30 days
7. Photo ID for all members of the household
