Harford Community Action Agency can help!

The COVID Water and Sewer Emergency Assistance Program provides financial assistance with water and sewer bills to Harford County residents who have experienced a financial loss due to the COVID 19 pandemic.

Anyone who is past due on their water and sewer bill or who needs financial assistance to help pay their bill should review the application and program guidelines at www.HarfordCAA.org. Applicants may be eligible for up to seven months' of financial assistance.

Past due bills prior to March 1, 2020 are not eligible for this funding. Funding is available first come, first served, and is dependent on the availability of Federal CARES Act funds.

Harford Community Action Agency will provide individuals and families an assessment and payment assistance. Payments are made directly to the water and sewer provider on the applicant's behalf. The Harford Community Action Agency will also help individuals apply for other programs including fuel assistance, eviction prevention, and food resources.
