

Integrated Education and Training Program

This free 8-week virtual program allows those 18+ to earn an industry-recognized Powered Industrial Truck Operator credential. Learn math concepts needed to operate industrial machinery like a forklift in an 8-week math class that will also prepare you for the GED[®] exam and satisfy the OHSA 1998 Powered Industrial Truck Operator Training requirements. Get hands-on training in operating a forklift and learn:

- Major causes of accidents
- Causes of fatalities and review graphs to understand and compute percentages
- Looking for hazards
- Using math computation to determine the stability of a lift truck, for example: weight, height, length, and width
- Pre-operational safety checks, such as electric truck daily checklist and/or internal combustion daily checklist
- Propane, gasoline, and diesel refueling
- Testing-taking strategies

The training prepares you for the GED[®] Math exam and the Forklift Certification exam. Completers can seek employment in local warehouse distribution sites throughout Harford County. To qualify, students must not be enrolled in school and be at least 18 and at a 7-8th grade level in reading and math.
